Attention All Artists of all kinds! Cry for Justice NEEDS you!

Whether your artistic gifting is in painting, chalks, beadwork, jewelry making, music, culinary or any other sort of art.... **CFJ NEEDS YOU!** We are creating a page on the CFJ website for donations of art and artistic services where people can shop and purchase your anointed artwork, the proceeds from which you in turn agree to donate to CFJ! Any and all forms of artwork will be accepted! The proceeds from the items sold will help fund our efforts to free children from the bondage of sexual slavery! This is your chance to use the gift God has given you to bless HIM back by helping to **FREE** His precious children! What an amazing opportunity for us to come together as artists and make a **REAL** difference by doing what you love!

CFJ Online Store

What is it?

An online store full of donated pieces of all kinds of art and artistic services, including but not limited to: paintings, jewelry, murals, quilts, music, poetry books, sculptures, culinary arts, etc. The sale of the art or service will be sold by you, and you will then donate the proceeds to Cry for Justice. You will play an critical role in our efforts to raise awareness about child sex slavery in the United States, as well as aid us in freeing and restoring these sexually exploited children.

How does it work?

Regardless of what kind of art you do, you may submit it for donation to the CFJ fundraising team. This can be done by filling out an Artist Submission Form. This form can be downloaded from The CFJ Online Store or picked up at the Abiding Glory International Ministry Base (see address below). Also, please take 2 to 3 digital pictures of it for posting online. You may email the Artist Submission Form to jessica@cryforjustice.org, mail it to Cry for Justice c/o Abiding Glory Ministries, 1610 Midpark Road, Knoxville, Tn. 37921, or deliver it to the same address in person. Your art work or service will then be posted at CryForJustice.org with your contact info and the valued price. Interested buyers will then be able to view your art, and if they choose to purchase it they will contact you directly.

Please **DO NOT** bring your art work to the ministry base. You, the artist, are solely responsible for the selling, delivering, and donating of the funds to CFJ, as well as the art work to the buyer. Once a piece is sold it should be delivered to the buyer within the promised timeframe, and the pledged proceeds should be donated to CFJ within a timely manner. We ask for all artists to show the utmost integrity by delivering the art or service in a timely fashion, as well as donating the full amount that you pledged to CFJ. The people buying your art through our online store are doing so to support Cry For Justice, and so we desperately want to honor their desire, not only to enjoy your art or service but also to help us bring an end to sexual trafficking. As you're

praying for a valued amount for your art work or service, please include delivery expenses. CFJ can in no way be responsible for the prices associated with delivering the art. When the artwork is sold please contact Jessica White within 48 hours at jessica@cryforjustice.org so it can be removed from the online store. **Please note: CFJ does reserve the right to refuse posting of any art or artistic service.**

How should the buyers pay, and Do tax deductible credits apply?

When a buyer sees your art work or artistic service online and they decide to purchase it then they will contact you directly. (Remember underneath your art/service we will post the contact info we receive from you on your Art Submission Form). They will then make arrangements with you personally via email or phone concerning their shipping or delivery address, and also where they are to send the money. At this time you will give them either your address or they can pay you on a personal pay-pal account (recommended). It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that they make the check out to YOU and **NOT** Cry for Justice or AGM. This is simply because CFJ in **NO WAY** can be responsible for the delivery of the money or art being sold or bought. CFJ is a non-profit organization and we will make the buyers aware in a description of our Online Art Store that you, the artist, are donating the funds you receive from your art to CFJ. CFJ can in no way be responsible for the delivery of the art work or service, or for the payment from the buyer. In other words, the entire transaction is solely between the artist and the buyer, and the artist is making a donation to CFJ from the proceeds. Since CFJ is a non-profit organization under the umbrella of Abiding Glory Ministries, the donation from the artist is tax deductible. At the end of the tax year, you will receive a Charitable Contribution Letter from Abiding Glory Ministries detailing your donation.

1) BUYER

The buyer gets **NO** Tax deduction for the purchasing of your artwork or service. If a buyer expresses the desire to give you more for your art work or service than the “fair market value” (what you have valued your art as) because they desire to help CFJ with a larger donation please encourage them to donate directly to CFJ either by mail or on our website, because that is the only way they will be able to receive a tax deduction from us.

2) SELLER (Artist)

You, the artist, get credit for the amount of the total value of the gift you donate to us. You must decide what the “fair market value” is for your art work or service, and it should be listed on your Art Submission Form as “valued price”. This is the amount that you would be able to receive a tax deduction for after you donate the money to CFJ after selling your art or artistic service. We would provide you a letter at the end of the year stating that you donated “x” amount of items at whatever total value.

How do I price my artwork?

As always we would ask that you consult the Holy Spirit for the right valued price of your art or artistic service being donated. We don't want you to undercharge or overcharge for the piece

or artistic service that God has given to you. Understand that if the art does not sell at the price you are asking after an extended period of time, we may encourage you to lower the price. Also, if we feel as though you could ask more for your art or service then we will encourage you to do so. However the prices will never be changed without permission from you, the artist.

What is the difference between “Art Work” and an “Artistic Service”?

Art comes in all kinds of forms. Many people only think of it as wall hangings, paintings, sculptures, and the like. But there is so much more to art, and some people have gifts that aren't a piece they can post online, but an artistic service they can donate and the payment for it could benefit CFJ. Some examples of this would be a photographer who would like to donate their proceeds made from taking wedding photos or Family Portraits. A culinary artist that would like to donate “x” amount of decorative cake services, or cater so many events with all or a percentage of the proceeds going to CFJ. Someone who paints murals might donate their service and the money made from it, or an interior designer who would donate 2 or 3 of their services and the money made from them to CFJ. Maybe you are a performer and you make a living that way, or do it just for fun...would you consider donating the proceeds of one of your plays, stand-up comedy routines or concerts for these exploited children? The possibilities are vast here, and we will have a place in the Online Store designated for these types of Services, where people can shop for these things that they might have need of and at the same time be helping CFJ through your generous donation of your Artistic Service. We realize that some of you do these services for a living and that maybe you can only afford to donate 1 or 2 of these services a year, or maybe you would just be willing to give a percentage of the proceeds from these services. We will make sure to differentiate services that 100% of the proceeds are going to CFJ from the ones that are giving a percentage so that those who are shopping with us will not be confused. Even if all you can do is give a percentage of even 1 service, every bit helps and we are thankful. At any time you want us to remove your services from the Online Store because you've reached your limit in what you can afford or for any other reason, please contact us and give us 7-10 days to remove it from the website.

Do I have to be local to donate the proceeds from my art work or service?

No! The beauty of our Online Store is that anyone from anywhere can make donations, and anyone from anywhere can buy it from you! So we welcome artists internationally to get on board with us and donate.

What if I'm not an artist? What else can I do to help?

Maybe you're not artistically gifted, but you probably know someone who is! For the Online CFJ store to work, we desperately need lots artists to donate, and “word of mouth” is the BEST way to get donors as well as buyers! Please tell everyone you know to check out our Online Store to either donate their artwork or to do their shopping for home décor, miscellaneous artistic

services, or gifts for **ANY** occasion! It is so fun to get things you need and want and make a HUGE difference at the same time! Also, a great way to help is to shop yourself! We are going to have absolutely **BEAUTIFUL** anointed pieces in our Online Store that will bring God's anointing, blessing, and beauty to your home or business! As you're telling others about us you are also spreading awareness about the horrors of human trafficking, and **YOU ARE MAKING A DIFFERENCE!** Please take some time to check out the info that we share about human trafficking and other ways to help at www.cryforjustice.org This way you will be educated about what's happening and will be able to passionately explain our cause to your friends, family and co-workers. We really can put an end to this horror by saving one child at a time. Would you please help us in any way you can?
